### **1. EXPERIENCE**

- a. Ric Burrous has been involved in the field of communications since graduating from Indiana University-Bloomington in 1974 with a degree in journalism. For nearly 14 years, he worked as a news reporter, sports editor and news/managing editor at The Daily Journal in Johnson County. He also has worked as a part-time writer in the sports departments of The Indianapolis Star and The Indianapolis News for nearly 20 years.

Burrous spent two years working for the Indiana General Assembly in the media relations office, then worked for two years at the Caldwell Van Riper Agency in the public relations departments, working for such clients as the GTE, the LPGA Mayflower Classic, the Radnor Corporation and the Indiana Pacers.

He has working in the communications and marketing office at IUPUI since 1991, working with such schools as the IU School of Dentistry, the IU School of Liberal Arts, the Purdue School of Engineering & Technology, the IU School of Nursing and the IU School of Physical Education.

After being named the news editor in the communications and marketing office, Burrous produced, wrote and edited Campuscape, IUPUI's employee new magazine, and became the editor of Partnerships, IUPUI's alumni magazine serving more than 120,000 graduates of IUPUI-based schools worldwide.

Burrous eventually was named news and photography editor for IUPUI, responsible for writing content for campus web sites and helping manage IUPUI's online photo gallery. He also coordinates photography for campus events, people and organizations, and supervises the "Amazing Students" and "Outstanding Faculty" web sites.
